FISCAL MEMORANDUM

SB 1490 – HB 1641

March 21, 2016

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Adds to the list of individuals exempt from firing range and classroom training requirements for the purpose of obtaining a handgun carry permit any honorably discharged and retired veteran of the United States armed forces who produces a DD 214 form indicating a discharge or retirement date within five years of application for the permit and that presents documentation of the successful completion of all handgun training of not less than four hours as required by any branch of the United States armed forces.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (014352): Deletes all language of the original bill. Adds language to Tenn. Code Ann. § 39-17-1351(e)(4) to clarify that any person seeking military exemption from the classroom and firing range training requirements to obtain a handgun carry permit may have completed the military handgun training at any time prior to submission of proof.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- Based on information provided by the Department of Safety, the provisions of the bill as amended are not expected to alter departmental operations.
- The legislation is not expected to impact state or local government expenditures or revenue.
