FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 458 – SB 513

April 4, 2016

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Encourages non-resident students at Tennessee public colleges and universities to receive immunization against meningococcal disease. Non-resident students shall not be required to show proof of immunization for admission.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (014369): Deletes all language of the original bill. Requires public institutions of higher education to accept documentation from a student's prior or current military service as proof of immunization required of the student for enrollment at the institution.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- Requiring public institutions of higher education to accept prior or current records relative to a student's military service as proof of immunization in order to satisfy the requirements of Tenn. Code Ann. § 49-7-124 relative to immunization at such institutions will have no fiscal impact on state or local government.
- No impact to the higher education outcomes-based funding formula.
