FISCAL NOTE

HB 19 - SB 120

January 29, 2015

SUMMARY OF BILL: Specifies that water, gas, and electric meter readers, and utility workers are exempt from the requirement to wear a vehicle safety belt when emerging from and reentering a vehicle at frequent intervals and when operating the vehicle at speeds not exceeding forty miles per hour.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- According to the Department of Safety, this bill will not affect the operations of the Department.
- Based on information provided by the Tennessee Sheriffs Association, the fiscal impact of this bill on local sheriffs is considered to be not significant.
- According to the County Technical Assistance Service, this bill will result in no fiscal impact to counties.
