FISCAL NOTE

HB 36 - SB 285

February 4, 2015

SUMMARY OF BILL: Removes the requirement that a student's Tennessee Comprehensive Assessment Program (TCAP) score be counted as a percentage of their final spring semester grades. Authorizes local boards of education to include a student's TCAP score and other state achievement test scores as part of their final spring semester grades. Authorizes local boards of education to continue using existing grading policies that include the incorporation of such test scores.

- No fiscal impact on state or local government.
