HB 258 - SB 420

February 18, 2015

SUMMARY OF BILL: Eliminates the requirement that law enforcement agencies, responsible for at least one investigation and arrest that resulted in a drug related conviction, report the amount of funds collected and paid to the general fund of the respective governing body and the amount spent on drug education and treatment to the Comptroller annually.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The Comptroller's office reports that they are unaware of a report of this nature ever being filed.
- Eliminating a requirement that is not adhered to or enforced under current law will not have a fiscal impact on state or local government.
