FISCAL NOTE

HB 578 - SB 1377

February 21, 2015

SUMMARY OF BILL: Adds drug fraud to those offenses for which one may have the public records expunged. The sentence for the offense must have been four years or less and ten years must have elapsed since the person completed the sentence.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Statistics from the Department of Correction show that the 10-year average for admissions under Tenn. Code Ann. § 53-11-402, drug fraud, are only 2.6 per year.
- It is assumed that few offenders will seek expunction of their records.
- Any impact to state and local revenue is not significant.
