**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 772 - SB 1229**

February 25, 2015

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Defines "lobbying expenditure" and requires each local board of education to include a line item in their budget that includes the amount to be spent on lobby expenditures. Requires each local board of education to submit a form to their governing legislative body that specifies all professional associations and lobbying expenditures. Sets forth the minimum requirements that the form shall include.

- The additional information related to lobbying expenditures will be prepared by each board of education during the normal course of the annual budget process and may be submitted electronically to the appropriate legislative body.
