HB 839 - SB 823

April 7, 2015

SUMMARY OF BILL: Increases, from two to three years, the period of time in which a tanning facility must maintain records with regards to signed waivers of customers.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Currently, prior to each use of a tanning facility, or each time an individual executes or renews a contract to use a tanning facility, the individual is required to sign a written statement that acknowledges the warning inherent in using the tanning device and the patient's requirement to use protective eyewear.
- Requiring a tanning facility to keep such statements for an additional year will have no impact on the state.
