FISCAL NOTE

HB 977 - SB 1222

March 15, 2015

SUMMARY OF BILL: Specifies that a physician must maintain records relating to abortion procedures for a period of five years.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Physicians are currently required to keep records related to the performance of abortions.
- Requiring a specific period of time that physicians must maintain such records will have no impact on the state. Any fiscal impact will be borne by the physicians.
- The provisions of the bill will not significantly affect the regulatory responsibilities of the Department of Health.
