**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 1129 - SB 1303**

March 22, 2015

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires the State to allow a state employee, upon retirement, to keep the employee's photo identification card for free.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- The Department of Human Resources's (DOHR) Policy 12-057, which became effective October 3, 2012, allows an employee to keep his or her badge upon retirement pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 8-50-118.
- The Department of General Services (DGS) is responsible for providing the retirement stickers to DOHR and DOHR in turn provides the stickers to various departments when an employee retires.
- The proposed bill is codifying the departments' current practice and will not result in a fiscal impact to state government.
- Estimate assumes that DGS can continue to charge an employee, retired or otherwise, the current \$10 fee for lost badges.
