HB 1170 - SB 1177

March 13, 2015

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes home rule municipalities or metropolitan governments to regulate and control the commercial use of pedal carriages and rickshaws as modes of transportation for hire within entertainment, dining, scenic, and/or historic areas.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT
