HB 1734 - SB 1781

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes the Tennessee Supreme Court to assume jurisdiction, upon its own motion, over an undecided case when a pending application for interlocutory or extraordinary appeal is filed with an immediate Tennessee appellate court.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Under current law, the Supreme Court can assume jurisdiction of these cases upon motion of any party. It is assumed that authorizing the Supreme Court to assume jurisdiction upon its own motion will not significantly impact the court's operations.
- The Administrative Office of the Courts confirms that the bill will not significantly impact their operations.
