FISCAL NOTE

HB 1786 - SB 1784

February 17, 2016

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes licensed wineries and farm wine producers to advertise and label products made from apples as “cider”, “apple cider”, or “hard cider”.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- An effective date of May 1, 2016.
- The bill does not change the products that wineries or farm wine producers are currently authorized to produce, manufacture, distribute, or sell at retail; the bill only changes how those products may be advertised and labeled.
- Both the Alcoholic Beverage Commission and the Department of Revenue confirm that the bill will have no impact on departmental operations.
- The fiscal impact of the bill is estimated to be not significant.
