**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 1793 – SB 1967**

February 16, 2016

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires the Department of Education (DOE) to evaluate the physical education curriculum in all public schools in Tennessee and to submit an annual report to the Education Committees of the General Assembly by July 1. Sets forth the data and other requirements that the report shall include.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- The DOE sends out a questionnaire from the Coordinated School Health Office to LEAs each year. Additional questions will be added to this annual questionnaire or placed on another form that the Department devises to effectuate the purpose of this bill.
- The DOE will compile and transmit the report in the normal course of business without an increase in personnel.
- Any increase in state or local expenditures is estimated to be not significant.
