FISCAL NOTE

HB 1945 - SB 2014

March 18, 2016

SUMMARY OF BILL: Increases, from two to three hours, the time period that underground utility operators are afforded to stake or mark the location of land affected by excavation or demolition to indicate the approximate location of all of the underground utilities that may be damaged as a result of such excavation or demolition.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- Based on information from the Tennessee Association of Utility Districts, any fiscal impact resulting from increasing the number of hours a underground utility operator is afforded to mark the approximate location of underground utilities possibly affected by excavation or demolition is estimated to be not significant.

IMPACT TO COMMERCE:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- The provisions of the bill will not impact commerce or jobs in Tennessee.
