**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 2095 - SB 2608**

February 6, 2016

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Creates a new Class A misdemeanor for knowingly installing, concealing, or otherwise placing an electronic tracking device in or on a motor vehicle without the owner or purchaser's written consent, if committed by someone who sells, leases, or otherwise transfers title of a motor vehicle.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- There will not be a sufficient number of prosecutions for state or local government to experience any significant increase in revenue or expenditures.
- It is assumed that any impact can be handled by the courts, district attorneys, and public defenders within their existing resources.
- The Administrative Office of the Courts, District Attorneys General Conference, and District Public Defenders Conference confirm that they can handle any impact within their existing resources.
