HB 2217 - SB 2406

SUMMARY OF BILL: Increases from “five or more” to “ten or more” the number of interested persons necessary to petition an agency requesting the adoption, amendment, or repeal of any rule pursuant to the Uniform Administrative Procedures Act.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Any change in the number of petitions for rule changes as a result of requiring ten or more individuals, rather than five or more individuals, petitioning an agency is estimated to be not significant.
- No significant change in the total number of rules adopted, amended, or repealed.
- The Secretary of State and the Department of General Services both confirm the bill will not impact departmental operations.
- The fiscal impact of the bill is estimated to be not significant.
