FISCAL NOTE

HB 2550 - SB 2527

March 3, 2016

SUMMARY OF BILL: Increases, from three to five, the number of business days within which notices of intent to appeal decisions under the Water Quality Control Act must be published on the Department of Environment and Conservation's (TDEC) website. Establishes that such notices and any other publications required by law shall be posted no later than 12, rather than 14, days prior to the date the appeal or agreed order will be heard by the Board of Water Quality, Oil, and Gas.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The notices of intent to appeal decisions under the Water Quality Control Act are published on the Department's website.
- Any fiscal impact due to the changing of time periods as proposed by the bill is estimated to be not significant and can be accommodated within existing resources and by current staff of the Department.
