SUMMARY OF BILL: States the General Assembly's opposition to any plan by the United States Congress to cut Medicare benefits and erode America's hard-earned retirement plan and social safety net. States the General Assembly's strong support of the strengthening and preservation of Medicare's ability to deliver high-quality health care in a cost efficient manner for current and future retirees. A certified copy of the resolution is to be transmitted to the Speaker and Clerk of the U.S. House of Representatives, the President and Secretary of the U.S. Senate, and each member of Tennessee's Congressional delegation.
