SUMMARY OF BILL: Condemns the global unrelenting persecution of Christians and acts of terror and aggression against Christians; calls upon the President, Congressional leaders, and Governors to speak out specifically about the global persecution of Christians; calls upon the United States State Department Ambassador-at-large for International Religious Freedom to address specifically, and as a top priority, the global persecution of Christians; encourages faith leaders of all denominations to join in speaking out against the global persecution of Christians.

Resolves that appropriate copies of this resolution be prepared and transmitted to the President of the United States, the Speaker and Clerk of the United States House of Representatives, and the President and Secretary of the United States Senate.
