**FISCAL NOTE**

**SB 68 – HB 246**

February 6, 2015

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Adds liability protections to landowners, lessees, occupants, or other persons in control of land or premises, when such land or premises is used for sport clay shooting, shooting sports, and other target shooting, including archery and shooting range activities.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- The Department of Agriculture confirms this bill will not have an operational impact on the department.
- The Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency (TWRA) confirms the bill could only operate to further reduce the liability of the agency for shooting ranges operated by the agency. Based on all information provided by TWRA, any change in agency revenue or expenditures is estimated to be not significant.
- There will not be a sufficient change in the number of civil court cases for state or local government to experience any significant change in revenue or expenditures.
- The fiscal impact to state and local government from providing additional liability protection to landowners, lessees, and land occupants that use land for the specified recreational endeavors is estimated to be not significant.
- Any other fiscal impact resulting from this bill is expected to occur between private parties.
