SB 211 –HB 933

February 11, 2015

SUMMARY OF BILL: Extends the termination date of the Emergency Communications Board (Board) to June 30, 2015. Under the *Tennessee Governmental Entity Review Law*, the board is scheduled to terminate on June 30, 2014.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The Board is currently in the wind down process pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-29-112. The proposed legislation will extend the wind down period for an additional year through June 30, 2016.
- This bill continues an existing entity at its current funding level.
- According to the Governor's Recommended Budget Document for FY 15-16 (page B-281), total recommended funding for the 911 Emergency Communications Fund for FY15-16 is \$117,696,800 (\$111,876,300 state and \$5,820,500 other)
