FISCAL NOTE

SB 314 - HB 274

February 22, 2015

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes any handgun carry permit holder to carry a handgun in any park or recreational area owned by the state or a local government. Removes the authority of local governments to prohibit by resolution the possession of handguns by valid handgun carry permit holders in parks or recreational areas owned or operated by the local government. Prohibits removal of any existing signs indicating that firearms are prohibited within any such park or recreational area. Removes existing provision concerning sign requirement when local governments elect to prohibit firearms in any such park or recreational area.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The Department of Safety, the Office of the Attorney General and Reporter, and the Administrative Office of the Courts all confirm this bill will result in no impact to their operations.
- The Tennessee Association of Chiefs of Police and the County Officials Association of Tennessee both confirm this bill will result in no impact to local government operations.
