**FISCAL NOTE**

**SB 387 - HB 897**

February 17, 2015

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires pawnbrokers to deliver records of every pawn transaction to the appropriate law enforcement agency by noon of the next business day, rather than within 48 hours following the day of the transactions.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumption:

- Local law enforcement agencies will accept the records as proposed under this legislation without incurring any additional expenditures.

**IMPACT TO COMMERCE:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumption:

- Requiring pawnbrokers to provide records of pawn transactions to the appropriate law enforcement agency on a more frequent basis will not result in a significant increase in business expenditures.
