SB 506 - HB 895

SUMMARY OF BILL: Reduces the amount a medical provider may charge an employee for medical reports, medical records, or documents relating to a workers' compensation claim from \$10.00 for the first 20 pages to \$10.00 for the first 30 pages.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- The Division of Worker's Compensation confirms the bill will have no fiscal impact on departmental operations.
- Any other fiscal impact as a result of this bill will be borne by private parties.

IMPACT TO COMMERCE:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- Any report printed over 20 pages in length will result in a minimal change in business revenue and business expenditures.
