**FISCAL NOTE**

**SB 598 - HB 616**

March 1, 2015

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Declares that no political subdivision may, by ordinance, resolution, or other means, prohibit the use of a motor vehicle within the jurisdictional boundaries of the political subdivision solely on the basis of being equipped with autonomous technology, if the motor vehicle otherwise complies with all safety regulations of the political subdivision. Defines the term "autonomous technology"..

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**
