SB 618 - HB 635

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes wineries and manufacturers or distillers to request approval from the Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission (ABC) to hold wine or alcoholic beverage festivals that last longer than 72 hours.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Authorizing ABC to extend the length of wine or alcoholic beverage festivals beyond the currently permitted maximum of 72 hours is estimated to result in a not significant increase in wine and alcoholic beverage sales. Any increase in state and local taxes imposed on such sales will be not significant.
- No additional personnel or resources will be required by the ABC.
