FISCAL NOTE

SB 633 - HB 683

March 5, 2015

SUMMARY OF BILL: Prohibits local education agency (LEA) employees from requiring a student or a student's parent to provide information on firearm ownership by the student's family. Prohibits an LEA from requiring their employees to provide information on firearm ownership. Prohibits any information on firearm ownership that is voluntarily provided by a student, parent, teacher, or other LEA employee from being the basis for disciplinary action taken against a student or teacher. Disciplinary action may still be taken for a violation based on Tenn. Code Ann. § Title 39, Chapter 17, Part 13.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- No change in the number of disciplinary hearings statewide.
- Any decrease in local expenditures as a result of keeping fewer records is estimated to be not significant.
