FISCAL NOTE

SB 667 - HB 830

March 16, 2015

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires each local education agency (LEA), in consultation with the Department of Education (DOE) and local law enforcement, to institute domestic violence awareness education programs for all middle and high school students. Such programs shall be age appropriate. All middle and high school students shall participate in at least one domestic violence program each year.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Current state standards for health education include providing age appropriate information relative to domestic violence and other types of abuse.
- Some LEAs may currently be meeting the requirements of this bill.
- Programs will be done in the normal course of school programs or assemblies.
- Based on information from the DOE, the Comptroller, and other sources, there are a variety of ways that an LEA could implement the bill's requirements without a significant increase in local expenditures.
