FISCAL NOTE

SB 917 - HB 1011

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires a record of delivery of alcoholic beverages or beer by a licensed retailer to include the signature of a person 21 years of age or older who was responsible for receiving the delivery.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Under current law, a record of all deliveries of alcoholic beverages or beer by a licensed retailer must be maintained in writing and must contain all information concerning the recipient, products delivered, the time of delivery and place of delivery.
- Requiring any such record to include the signature of a person 21 years of age or older who is responsible for receiving the delivery will not have a significant impact on beer and alcoholic beverage sales and will not result in a significant fiscal impact to the Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission.
