FISCAL NOTE

SB 920 - HB 1313

March 20, 2015

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Comptroller of Treasury, in cooperation with the Tennessee Regulatory Authority, to provide the currently required annual report on the status of broadband services to the chair of Business and Utilities Committee of the House of Representatives and to the chair of the Senate Commerce and Labor Committee, rather than to the General Assembly. Requires the report by January 15 of each year, rather than by January 31 of each year.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- Any impact resulting from the Comptroller of Treasury providing an annual report to the chair of Business and Utilities Committee of the House of Representatives and to the chair of the Senate Commerce and Labor Committee on the status of broadband services by January 15 each year is estimated to be not significant.

IMPACT TO COMMERCE:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

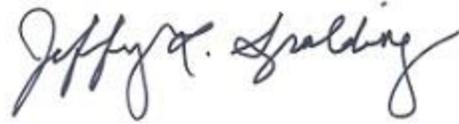
Assumption:

- Any impact to commerce resulting from the Comptroller of Treasury providing an annual report to the chair of Business and Utilities Committee of the House of Representatives and the chair of the Senate Commerce and Labor Committee on the status of broadband services by January 15 each year will not impact business revenue or expenditures.
