**FISCAL NOTE**

**SB 1095 - HB 1296**

March 17, 2015

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires the governor, in making member-appointments to the Motor Vehicle Commission, to strive to ensure that at least one person serving on the commission is a woman.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- Currently, there are 17 member of the commission and the Governor must strive to ensure that at least one person serving on the commission is 60 years of age or older and at least one person is of a racial minority.
- The provisions of the bill will not change the total number of commission members and will not significantly alter the current operations of the commission; therefore, any fiscal impact is not significant.
