SB 1273 - HB 1363

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires cages at Class I wildlife facilities to provide sufficient space to allow for an animal's adequate freedom of movement to make normal postural and social adjustments.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Based on information received from the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency, mandating the type of cages at Class I wildlife facilities will not change the licensure or regulatory actions of the agency. Any fiscal effects realized from the provisions of the bill will be borne by the private facilities; therefore, any impact to state and local government is estimated to be not significant.
