**FISCAL NOTE**

**SB 1473 – HB 1523**

February 24, 2016

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Increases, from 10 to 30, the number of days a utility facility owner located in a state highway right-of-way has to respond to a second relocation notice, and the number of days an owner has to file the reservation of rights notice with the Department of Transportation (TDOT).

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumption:

- Increasing the number of days that an owner of a utility facility has to respond to a second relocation notice and to file the reservation of rights notice will not result in a decrease in the number of utility relocation projects undertaken or a significant delay of any such projects. Therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
