FISCAL NOTE

SB 1490 – HB 1641

January 19, 2016

SUMMARY OF BILL: Adds to the list of individuals exempt from firing range and classroom training requirements for the purpose of obtaining a handgun carry permit any honorably discharged and retired veteran of the United States armed forces who produces a DD 214 form indicating a discharge or retirement date within five years of application for the permit and that presents documentation of the successful completion of all handgun training of not less than four hours as required by any branch of the United States armed forces.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- According to the Department of Safety and Homeland Security (DOS), currently the department exempts anyone who within the last five years has completed four hours of training from any branch of the military.
- DOS indicates the department will have to determine how to confirm the four-hour training requirement since the DD 214 does not specifically list this information.
- DOS indicates that no fiscal impact is expected.
