SB 1493 - HB 1474

SUMMARY OF BILL: Exempts motor vehicles owned or leased by licensed private investigators or private investigations companies from the current restrictions on the darkness of window tint materials permitted for motor vehicles registered in this state.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- There will not be a sufficient reduction in the number of window tinting citations issued; therefore, any impact to state and local government revenue and expenditures is estimated to be not significant.
- Based on information provided by the Department of Safety, the Tennessee Sherriff's Association, and the Tennessee Association of Chiefs of Police, the fiscal impact of the bill is estimated to be not significant.
