FISCAL NOTE

SB 1667 – HB 1750

February 11, 2016

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes a sheriff or a deputy sheriff, certified by the Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) Commission, who is employed by a county as a court officer or corrections officer, to carry firearms at all times and in all places in Tennessee regardless of the officer's regular duty hours or assignment, unless otherwise prohibited by federal law, court order, or otherwise by law.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Based on information provided by the Department of Safety, there will be no impact to departmental operations.
- It is assumed that all applicable sheriffs and deputy sheriffs have already been issued service firearms; as a result, no additional firearms will need to be acquired or issued as a result of the bill.
- The Tennessee Sheriff's Association confirms the bill will not impact local government operations and will not result in a significant fiscal impact.
