**FISCAL NOTE**

**SB 1764 - HB 1865**

January 29, 2016

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires agents and the Assistant Director of the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) to satisfactorily complete a course of study that includes current national drug trends and investigations, selected and approved by the TBI, if the Federal Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) ceases to operate such schools that offer the course of study.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- Under current law, the agents and Assistant Director of the TBI are required to satisfactorily complete a course of study at a school operated by the DEA. The bill provides for an alternative course if the DEA ceases to operate such schools.
- TBI confirms that the bill will not significantly impact its operations.
