FISCAL NOTE

SB 1800 - HB 1990

SUMMARY OF BILL: Increases the membership of the Viticulture Advisory Board (VAB) from 9 members to 11 members. The two new additional members shall each be appointed separately by the Speaker of the House of Representative and the Speaker of the Senate, from their respective legislative bodies. Entitles these two new legislative members of the VAB to mileage expense reimbursement and an expense allowance pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 3-1-106 for each one-day board meeting a member attends; provided that no such member shall receive any additional legislative compensation when the General Assembly is in session or if a board member is being paid any other payments on the same dates for attendance on other state business. An effective date of July 1, 2016.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures - \$700/Each One-Day Meeting

Assumptions:

- The Viticulture Advisory Board meets approximately 3 to 4 times per year.
- Meetings are held in various locations across the state.
- It is assumed that meetings of the Board will take place on dates in which the General Assembly is not in session and the legislative board members are not being paid any other payments for attendance to state business.
- Travel and per diem expenses for two legislative members of \$687.18 per meeting (\$204 per diem plus \$139.59 mileage for each member).
