FISCAL NOTE

SB 2051 - HB 2192

February 25, 2016

SUMMARY OF BILL: Extends from September 15, 2017, to September 15, 2018, the date by which the Tennessee Advisory Commission on Intergovernmental Relations (TACIR) is required to report on 911 surcharges and the implementation of IP-based next generation 911 technology to the Government Operations Joint Committee.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-86-131, TACIR must study and report its conclusions on 911 surcharge revenue and the expansion of the 911 system to the Joint Committee on Government Operations on or before September 15, 2017.
- Extending the period of time by one additional year for TACIR to submit the report will have no fiscal impact on state or local government.
