CONSENT CALENDAR

1. [SB 1703](#) *Briggs (HB 2519 by *Armstrong)

Naming and Designating - As introduced, designates the supreme court building located in the city of Knoxville as the "Edward T. Sanford State Supreme Court Building." -

2. [HJR 0231](#) *VanHuss, Terry, Hill T, DeBerry, Matlock, Hill M, Keisling, Holsclaw, Holt, Brooks K, Calfee, Byrd, Carter, Mitchell, Spivey, Sexton J, Ragan, Rogers, Powers, Pody, Matheny, Jernigan, Littleton, Eldridge, Lamberth, Forgety, Hulsey, Goins, Towns, Johnson, Windle, Sparks, Lundberg, Sanderson, Ramsey, Camper, Todd, Faison, Weaver, Reedy, Halford

Naming and Designating - Designates the Barrett Model M82/M107 as the official rifle of the State of Tennessee. -

3. [SB 1430](#) *Niceley (HB 1405 by *Lollar, McDaniel, Pody, Brooks K)

State Symbols - As introduced, designates the state flag's center emblem of a blue circle with three white five-pointed stars as the official state symbol. - Amends TCA Title 4, Chapter 1.

1. [SB 0377](#) *Ketron (HB 0261 by *Matheny)

Purchasing and Procurement - As introduced, increases time the fiscal review committee may comment on noncompetitive contracts from 40 business days to 45 business days. - Amends TCA Title 4, Chapter 56; Title 12; Title 41, Chapter 22 and Title 49, Chapter 3.

2. [SB 1462](#) *Bailey (HB 1439 by *Williams)

County Government - As introduced, allows removal of overgrown vegetation and accumulated debris on owner-occupied residential property in Putnam County. - Amends TCA Section 5-1-115.

3. [SB 1480](#) *Bailey (HB 2436 by *Williams)

Cemeteries - As introduced, authorizes all local governments to use local funds to rehabilitate or maintain dilapidated or abandoned cemeteries. - Amends TCA Title 46, Chapter 2, Part 1.

4. [SB 1587](#) *Overbey (HB 1870 by *Farmer)

Pensions and Retirement Benefits - As introduced, authorizes all public pension and retirement plans, including those of utility districts and other local governmental entities, to recognize a qualified domestic relations order that directs the entity to allocate a portion of a member's benefits to the member's former spouse. - Amends TCA Section 26-2-105.

5. [SB 1593](#) *Beavers (HB 1663 by *Weaver)
Election Laws - As introduced, lowers period of early voting for stand-alone municipal elections in cities with 750 or less registered voters to not more than 15 days nor less than seven days before election day instead of not more than 20 days nor less than five days before election day. - Amends TCA Title 2, Chapter 6, Part 1.

6. [SB 1616](#) *Green (HB 1628 by *Pitts, Johnson, Reedy)
County Government - As introduced, removes provision for Montgomery County that allowed the county to impose an additional penalty of 20 percent on suits to enforce tax liens for the purpose of defraying the expenses of such suits; places Montgomery County with other counties which impose an additional penalty of 10 percent for such purposes. - Amends TCA Section 67-5-2410.

7. [SB 1622](#) *Johnson (HB 1521 by *Casada)
Legal Services, Office of - As introduced, revises functions of the office of legal services including duties pertaining to the code commission and duties of the revisor of statutes within the office of legal services. - Amends TCA Section 1-1-101; Section 1-1-102 and Section 3-12-109.

8. [SB 1645](#) *Briggs (HB 1688 by *Hicks)
Industrial Development - As introduced, requires that annual PILOT lessee reports and other economic development agreements be filed with the comptroller of the treasury instead of the state board of equalization. - Amends TCA Title 4, Chapter 7, Part 3; Section 7-53-305; Section 7-67-114 and Section 48-101-312.

9. [SB 1775](#) *McNally (HB 2047 by *McDaniel)
State Government - As introduced, transfers bomb and arson section within the department of commerce and insurance to the TBI. - Amends TCA Title 38, Chapter 6 and Title 68, Chapter 102.

10. [SB 1811](#) *Haile (HB 2053 by *Weaver)
Election Laws - As introduced, excludes residents of correctional institutions from being considered in reapportionment. - Amends TCA Title 5 and Title 41.

11. [SB 1837](#) *Green (HB 2253 by *Hazlewood)
State Employees - As introduced, prohibits commissioner of human resources from establishing minimum qualifications for any position in preferred service that requires an applicant to currently be employed by the state. - Amends TCA Title 8, Chapter 30.

12. [SB 1875](#) *Johnson (HB 1913 by *Casada)
Taxes, Hotel Motel - As introduced, authorizes the City of Spring Hill to levy a privilege tax upon the privilege of occupancy by a 2/3 vote of its governing body. - Amends TCA Section 67-4-1425.

13. [SB 0685](#) *Yager (HB 0705 by *Hulsey)
Public Records - As introduced, allows any register of deeds, instead of only those in certain counties, to redact social security numbers on recorded documents maintained on computers; allows any register of deeds, instead of only those in certain counties, to redact social security numbers on recorded documents at the request of certain persons if practicable. - Amends TCA Section 10-7-515.

14. [SB 1565](#) *Yager (HB 1667 by *Durham)
Lottery, Charitable - As introduced, removes permanent disqualification for organizations failing to return requisite percentage of gross proceeds to charitable purposes or programs in two consecutive annual event periods and replaces with a five-year disqualification; prohibits disbursement of prizes to ineligible participants and authorizes alternate selection of winners for such prizes within 30 days of the annual event; revises other provisions of the Tennessee Charitable Gaming Implementation Law. - Amends TCA Title 3, Chapter 17.

15. [SB 1566](#) *Yager (HB 1979 by *Ramsey)
Charitable Solicitations - As introduced, specifies that educational institutions exempt from registering with the division of charitable solicitations, includes institutions that are approved by the local board of education, the ASD, or the state board of education; extends certain renewal of registration filings for an additional 60 days. - Amends TCA Title 48, Chapter 101.

16. [SB 1626](#) *Yager, Ketrone (HB 1742 by *McCormick, Hardaway)
Election Laws - As introduced, establishes an online voter registration system beginning July 1, 2017. - Amends TCA Title 2, Chapter 2, Part 1.

17. [SB 1742](#) *Yager (HB 2347 by *Calfee)
Public Records - As introduced, requires a local government entity to make records of proposals and statements that are received by the local government in response to a service request or a request for solicitation open for public inspection only after the contract award is announced. - Amends TCA Section 10-7-504.
