CONSENT CALENDAR

1. [SB 1577](#) *McNally (HB 2152 by *Ragan)

Motor Vehicles - As introduced, expands authorization of all-terrain vehicles on certain portions of state highways in City of Rocky Top in Anderson County. - Amends TCA Section 55-8-185.

2. [SB 1650](#) *Tracy, Ramsey (HB 2181 by *Hill T)

Motor Vehicles - As introduced, authorizes off-highway vehicles on State Route 167 in Johnson County from Roan Creek Campground to Doe Mountain. - Amends TCA Title 11, Chapter 25, Part 1 and Title 55, Chapter 8.

3. [SB 2333](#) *Tracy (HB 2173 by *Matlock)

Motor Vehicles - As introduced, allows a motor vehicle to be operated, or to be equipped with, an integrated electronic display visible to the operator while the motor vehicle's autonomous technology is engaged. - Amends TCA Title 55, Chapter 8 and Title 55, Chapter 9, Part 1.

REGULAR CALENDAR

1. [SB 2199](#) *Bailey (HB 2330 by *Sexton C)

Traffic Safety - As introduced, imposes a fine of \$200 for parking violations on two-lane state highways where the illegally parked vehicle restricts access to emergency vehicles. - Amends TCA Title 55, Chapter 8.

2. [SB 1705](#) *Briggs (HB 1711 by *Smith)

Traffic Safety - As introduced, establishes categories of, and equipment and manufacturing standards for, electric bicycles; authorizes use of electric bicycles on routes designated for use of bicycles; excludes electric bicycles from definition of "motor vehicle"; excludes electric bicycles from driver licensing, insurance, registration, and other requirements applicable to motor vehicles. - Amends TCA Section 54-10-111; Section 54-5-142; Section 54-5-211 and Title 55.

3. [SB 1489](#) *Green (HB 1782 by *Johnson, Kumar)
Motor Vehicles - As introduced, enacts "Lara's Law," which requires used motor vehicle dealers to notify purchasers of used motor vehicles of certain recalls pertaining to the motor vehicle prior to the sale. - Amends TCA Title 47; Title 55 and Title 62.

4. [SB 2634](#) *Green (HB 2607 by *Sparks)
Aircraft and Airports - As introduced, directs the commissioner of transportation, in consultation with the commissioner of safety, to petition the federal aviation administration for a certificate of authority to operate unmanned aerial systems within the navigable airspace of each of the grand divisions of the state; enacts other provisions regarding unmanned aerial systems. - Amends TCA Title 4, Chapter 3; Title 39; Title 42; Title 49; Title 54; Title 55 and Title 70.

5. [SB 2252](#) *Hensley (HB 1806 by *Doss)
Disabled Persons - As introduced, exempts persons 65 and older who are disabled from fees for issuance and renewal of disabled parking placards and plates. - Amends TCA Title 55, Chapter 21 and Title 55, Chapter 4.

6. [SB 2093](#) *Ketron, Yarbrow, Dickerson, Tracy (HB 2407 by *Sargent, Clemmons, Powell, Stewart, Sparks, White D, Casada, McCormick, Johnson, Matlock, Dunn, Lundberg, Hazlewood, McManus)
Highways, Roads and Bridges - As introduced, enacts the "Public-Private Transportation Act of 2016." - Amends TCA Title 4; Title 6; Title 9; Title 12; Title 54; Title 55; Title 65 and Title 67.

7. [SB 1674](#) *Kyle (HB 1468 by *Clemmons, Powell)
Traffic Safety - As introduced, deletes requirement that the child safety seat for a child age one through three weighing more than 20 pounds be secured in a forward-facing position. - Amends TCA Title 55, Chapter 9, Part 6.

8. [SB 1596](#) *Massey (HB 1484 by *Smith)
School Transportation - As introduced, broadens the scope of the offense regarding a school bus driver using certain electronic devices while operating a bus with a child on board and increases the penalty for the offense. - Amends TCA Title 39 and Title 55.

9. [SB 1697](#) *Massey (HB 1487 by *Clemmons)

Traffic Safety - As introduced, creates a Class C misdemeanor offense of operating a motor vehicle within a bicycle lane; allows vehicular use of bicycle lanes only when legally parking the vehicle or turning into a road. - Amends TCA Title 55, Chapter 8.

10. [SB 1980](#) *Massey (HB 2471 by *Calfee)

Recreational Vehicles - As introduced, enacts the "Tennessee Recreation Vehicle Franchise Act of 2016"; establishes licensing requirements specifically for recreational vehicle dealers and salespersons to be overseen by the Tennessee motor vehicle commission. - Amends TCA Title 55.

11. [SB 1730](#) *Roberts (HB 1514 by *Pitts, Kumar, Rogers)

Highway Signs - As introduced, enacts the "Tyler Head Law," which creates a memorial sign program for persons who died in accidents caused by drivers under the influence of drugs or alcohol. - Amends TCA Title 39; Title 54 and Title 55.

12. [SB 2229](#) *Southerland (HB 2045 by *Alexander)

Motor Vehicles - As introduced, redefines "autocycle" and clarifies definitions related to the weight or engine displacement of all-terrain vehicles and autocycles; prohibits a person from operating an autocycle with a child passenger if such child is required to use a car seat in a passenger car. - Amends TCA Title 11; Title 47 and Title 55.
