- [SB 2091](#) *Ketrone, Green, Beavers, Jackson, Haile, Yager** (HB 2239 by *Lamberth, Casada, Littleton, Powers, Kumar, Brooks K, Terry, Powell, McCormick, White M, Butt, Farmer, Towns, Beck, Doss, Akbari, Camper, Kane, Fitzhugh, Johnson, Shepard, Hill M)
Insurance, Health, Accident - As introduced, prohibits an insurance policy that provides benefits for anti-cancer medications that are injected or intravenously administered by a healthcare provider and anti-cancer medications that are patient administered from requiring a higher copayment, deductible, or coinsurance amount. - Amends TCA Title 56, Chapter 7, Part 23.
- [SB 1594](#) *Beavers** (HB 1710 by *VanHuss)
Charitable Institutions - As introduced, exempts certain 501(c)(4) entities, operating as advocacy organizations, from registering as a charitable organization. - Amends TCA Title 48, Chapter 101, Part 5.
- [SB 1486](#) *Green** (HB 1637 by *Johnson)
Immigration - As introduced, enacts the "Tennessee Workers Protection Act." - Amends TCA Title 4; Title 7; Title 12 and Title 50.
- [SB 1871](#) *Johnson** (HB 2337 by *Jenkins)
Business Organizations - As introduced, revises various provisions pertaining to dissolution of certain business entities. - Amends TCA Title 48.

5. [SB 1928](#) ***Johnson, Bell, Briggs, Ramsey, Norris, Stevens, Gardenhire, Watson** (HB 2049 by *Eldridge, Clemmons, Hardaway, Miller)

Consumer Protection - As introduced, enacts the "Government Imposter and Deceptive Advertisements Act." - Amends TCA Title 47, Chapter 18.

6. [SB 2108](#) ***Johnson** (HB 2060 by *Casada)

Professions and Occupations - As introduced, allows state licensed or certified real estate appraisers to comply with a standard of valuation practice other than the Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice when performing an appraisal for any purpose other than a federally related transaction. - Amends TCA Title 62, Chapter 39.

7. [SB 2535](#) ***Norris, Johnson** (HB 1533 by *McCormick, Brooks K)

Commerce and Insurance, Dept. of - As introduced, allows the state fire marshal to require and perform field inspections in lieu of requiring review and approval of plans and specifications for construction and alteration of certain buildings or structures, and to charge a fee of no more than \$200 for inspections that were untimely requested. - Amends TCA Section 68-120-101.

8. [SB 2556](#) ***Norris, Johnson** (HB 1552 by *McCormick, Brooks K)

Unemployment Compensation - As introduced, revises provisions governing seasonal employment; adds provisions regarding taxable wage base; revises other provisions. - Amends TCA Section 50-7-213; Section 50-7-306; Section 50-7-404 and Section 50-7-715.

9. [SJR 0458](#) ***Niceley**

General Assembly, Statement of Intent or Position - Expresses support for the legalization of the sale of custom processed meat in Tennessee. -

10. [SB 2555](#) ***Norris** (HB 1551 by *McCormick, Brooks K, Lynn)

Labor and Workforce Development, Dept. of - As introduced, replaces references to various divisions and programs to reflect new structure of divisions within the department and to reflect appropriate name of federal programs. - Amends TCA Title 4, Chapter 3, Part 1; Title 4, Chapter 3, Part 14 and Section 8-35-221(a).

11. [SB 2402](#) *Overbey (HB 2228 by *Zachary)

Insurance Companies, Agents, Brokers, Policies - As introduced, establishes a new method by which a captive insurance company may redomesticate to this state; requires legal actions brought against a protected cell captive insurance company to specify which protected cells are a party to a suit; makes changes with regard to the taxation of certain captive insurance companies and those who own such companies. - Amends TCA Title 56.

12. [SB 1668](#) *Yager (HB 2344 by *Calfee)

Charitable Institutions - As introduced, authorizes an organization to submit its annual form requesting exemption from certain charitable solicitations registration and filing requirements at the same time and to the same division within the secretary of state's office as its annual report; reduces time period for such organization to claim the exemption. - Amends TCA Title 48.

13. [SB 1942](#) *Yager (HB 2345 by *Calfee)

Transitory Vendors - As introduced, requires the clerk to submit a report by July 1, 2016, and quarterly thereafter, to the office of local government; requires the report to identify applicants for a mobile vendor's permit who fail to provide the county clerk with the appropriate vendor and vehicle information. - Amends TCA Title 4; Title 5; Title 6; Title 47; Title 48; Title 50; Title 53; Title 55; Title 62 and Title 67.
