

HOUSE BILL 351

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 57,  
Chapter 5, Part 1, relative to beer permits.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-5-113, is amended by designating the existing language as subsection (a) and by adding the following language as a new subsection (b):

(b) Notwithstanding any provision of this chapter to the contrary, the beer board of any county having a metropolitan form of government with a population of more than six hundred thousand (600,000), according to the 2010 federal census or any subsequent federal census, shall issue a permit under this chapter authorizing consumption of beer on the premises to any holder of a license to sell alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises under chapter 4 of this title upon the submission of an application and payment of the applicable permit fee.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
