FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 995 – SB 1077

March 28, 2017

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Increases, from 60 to 75 days, the time period a handgun carry permit holder has to notify the Department of Safety of a change of address.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (006325): Deletes all language after the enacting clause. Defines the term “school property in use”, for the purpose of legally allowing a handgun carry permit holder to possess a handgun, to be “in use” as when one or more students are physically present on the property for an activity a reasonable person knows or should know is a school-sanctioned athletic event, or other school event.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- The provisions of the legislation are not expected to impact handgun carry permit applications or renewals.
- Any impact on state or local law enforcement agency expenditures is estimated to be not significant.
- The provisions of the legislation are not estimated create additional or reduce the number of areas in which a handgun carry permit holder may possess a handgun.
