FISCAL MEMORANDUM

SB 2351 – HB 2642

February 17, 2018

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Requires the identification carried by reserve or auxiliary officers operating law enforcement vehicles to bear the officer's photograph and identifying information.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (012865): Deletes all language after the enacting clause. Authorizes a personal vehicle operated by a transportation network company driver to display one or more removable, illuminated, interior trade dress devices in any color other than red or blue that is issued by a transportation network company that assists passengers in identifying and communicating with transportation network company drivers. Prohibits any such device from exceeding five candlepower.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

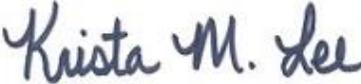
Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 55-9-402(d)(3), no vehicle operated in this state shall be equipped with any steady-burning lights that display to the front of the vehicle in any color other than white or amber or in any combination of colors other than white and amber, except for certain vehicles as specified.
- The proposed legislation would add personal vehicles operated by a transportation network company driver meeting certain criteria to the vehicles that are exempt from any violation of Tenn. Code Ann. § 55-9-402(d)(3).
- Any violation of Tenn. Code Ann. § 55-9-402 is a Class C misdemeanor offense.
- There will not be a sufficient decrease in the number of Class C misdemeanor offenses for state or local government to experience any significant decrease in revenue or expenditures.
- Any impact to state or local government is estimated to be not significant.
