FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 2082 – SB 2654

March 19, 2018

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Deletes reference to specific facilities of the Tennessee State Museum regarding when museum facilities are to remain open.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (015571): Deletes and rewrites all language after the enacting clause such that the substantive changes (1) require the Douglas Henry State Museum Commission (DHSMC) to prescribe hours of operation for the three state museum facilities, and (2) authorize the DHSMC to name any portion of the museum.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- The proposed language adds reference to the new museum facility, but does not alter the context of current law, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-12-104, as to when museum facility locations are to remain open.
- Authorizing the DHSMC to name portions of the museum and determine the hours of operation for the new museum facility will not result in any significant fiscal impact to state government.
