**FISCAL MEMORANDUM**

**SB 1708 – HB 1765**

March 19, 2018

**SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL:** Rearranges provisions within Tennessee Code Annotated governing earthquake and fire drills in schools.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

**SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (015190):** Adds language to the original bill to require public schools to conduct one armed intruder drill that includes a school lock down within the first 30 school days of a school year.

**FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:**

**Unchanged from the original fiscal note.**

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- No significant impact to state government operations.
- Local education agencies will be able to conduct the drills in accordance with the provisions of this legislation during the normal course of business; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
