FISCAL MEMORANDUM

SB 1502 – HB 2426

April 25, 2018

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Requires driver's education courses to include an area of instruction regarding the effects on driving abilities while talking or texting on a mobile phone.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (017840): Adds language to the original bill which prohibits student growth data generated by assessments in the 2017-2018 school year from being used by the State Board of Education (SBE) or the Department of Education (DOE) to implement or enforce any rule, policy, or guideline that prescribes remediation, observation, monitoring, assignment, professional development, or training requirements upon the teacher or principal.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

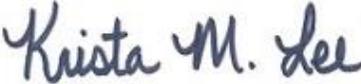
Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- The DOE will be able to amend its policies in accordance with the provisions of this legislation during the normal course of business; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- The SBE will be able to amend its policies in accordance with the provisions of this legislation during the normal course of business; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- No significant impact on local government operations.
