FISCAL NOTE

HB 162 - SB 286

March 8, 2017

SUMMARY OF BILL: Makes a change to the list of information required on an application for a voter to vote absentee concerning the address to mail the ballot outside the county.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Under current law, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 2-6-202, voters, except those possessing a commercial driver license or transportation worker identification, requesting an absentee ballot must file an application with the county election commission in order to absentee vote.
- The application requires the voter to list the address outside of the county where the voter wishes to have the ballot mailed.
- The provisions of the bill would authorize voters to vote absentee without having the ballot be mailed to an address which is outside the county.
- Authorizing other voters to receive absentee ballots will not result in any significant impact to state or local government.
